Work of the Subcommittee: October 2019 - February 2020

- Final report submitted in February 2020
- Six recommendations accepted by the DEB.
- Three require a vote of the membership
- ▶ Three can be handled by the DEB.

Six Recommendations


- Change name to SDBG Volunteer Society*
- Add a Volunteer Coordinator
- Do not establish a formal Mentoring Program
- All Active Volunteers can Vote*
- ► All Active Volunteers are eligible to hold office*
- Report Docent and Volunteer milestones together


Background: Who We Are

- ► All volunteers are members of the Docent Society
- Around 350 volunteers worked in the Garden in 2018
 - ▶ 56% were **Docents** and 44% **Volunteers**



Background: What we do

- ► Those 350 volunteers worked almost 50,000 hours
 - ▶ 74% of the hours were worked by Docents and 24% by Volunteers




What is the New Volunteer Retention Rate?

- ▶ 217 New Volunteers
- ▶ **50**% retention rate*
- Compares with 65% for San Diego/Carlsbad**

Not retained

*Mid 2017 to Fall 2019 **2015 National survey



- Change name to SDBG Volunteer Society
 - ► Half of Docent Society's members are Volunteers
 - ▶ Volunteers contribute a quarter of all hours (12,500 in 2018)
 - ▶ DEB focuses on all volunteers
 - ► Change makes clear that the Society works on everyone's behalf.
 - Status: Endorsed by the DEB. Requires a vote of the membership.

- Establish a Volunteer Coordinator position with a focus on retaining new volunteers
 - ► Purpose: integrate new volunteers into the Garden
 - ► Parallel to current Docent Coordinator position
 - Would contact new volunteers and help them get settled in the Garden
 - * Status: Accepted by the DEB. Appointment on hold during the pandemic.

- Do not create a formal mentoring program at this time
 - ► Mentoring programs require considerable structure and oversight
 - Often such programs are unsuccessful
 - Recommend Volunteer Coordinator position.
 - Status: Accepted by the DEB. No further action required.

- Revise the Operating Regulations to allow all active Docents and Volunteers to vote.
 - ► Volunteers are close to half the Society's membership and work close almost a quarter of the hours,
 - ► Volunteers are represented by the Officers and most of the Coordinators of the Society.
 - Active volunteers should be able to vote for those who represent them
 - Status: Endorsed by the DEB. Requires a vote of the membership.

- Revise the Operating Regulations to allow all active Docents and Volunteers to hold office.
 - ► Increases options for Nominating Committee
 - Makes it clear that all volunteers are welcome in the group.
 - Qualifications would not change: still requires appropriate knowledge and substantial time commitment.
 - Status: Endorsed by the DEB. Requires a vote of the membership.

- Continue to record hours separately for Docents and Volunteers but report all milestones (Docents and Volunteers) together.
 - ► Committee reviewed procedures for other ways to make all volunteers feel welcome.
 - Recommending this small change to emphasize that everyone's hours are valued
 - Status: Accepted by the DEB in principle. Details still need to be worked out.

Next steps

- ► Active Docents will vote in September (Zoom Poll) on the three items requiring a change to the operating regulations:
 - 1. Should the name change to SDBG Volunteer Society?
 - 2. Should all Society members be allowed to vote?
 - 3. Should all Society members be able to hold office?
